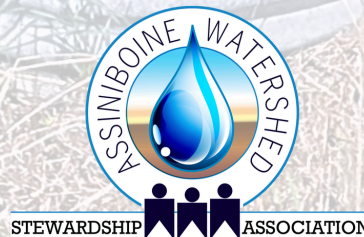
Over 90% of residents rely on groundwater for drinking.

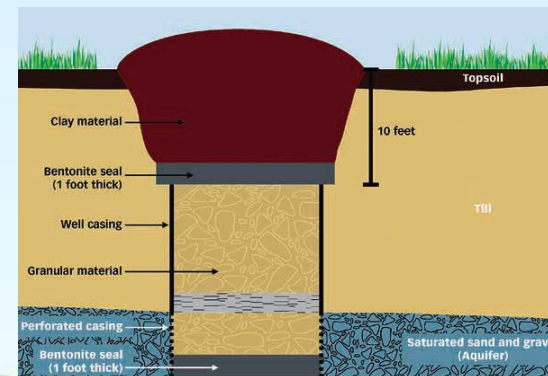
