Did you know.....

CHANGE IN MAILING ADDRESS AND/OR NEW OWNERSHIP OF PROPERTY:

Please advise the Municipal Office promptly of any address changes to ensure the tax bill is forwarded to the proper owner(s). Failure to receive a tax bill does not excuse an owner from the responsibility for any late penalties. If you have owned the home for only part of the year, any arrangements to collect portions from the previous owner is strictly between the vendor and purchaser.

BEAVER CONTROL PROGRAM

The RM participates in the Provincial Beaver Control Program. Any ratepayer or authorized person that destroys beavers within this municipality and can provide proof to the RM councillor (beaver tail) and a valid trapper's license will be compensated \$50.00 per beaver tail. Without a valid license you will be compensated \$30.00 per beaver tail.

PRIMARY WEIGHT PERMITS

Please be advised all roads besides the Rhein Grid are secondary weight and anyone hauling primary weight purchase a permit per truck from the office.

Permits cost \$100.00 per license, per calendar year.

All haulers hauling goods or commodities over any road in the RM on a continuous basis must sign a 'Road Haul Agreement' with the municipality.
