PRIMARY WEIGHT PERMITS

Please be advised all roads besides the Rhein Grid are secondary weight and anyone hauling primary weight must purchase a permit per truck from the office.

Permits cost \$100.00 per license, per calendar year.

Permits can be purchased at the municipal office located at 26 – 5th Ave N, Yorkton, SK.

All haulers hauling goods or commodities over any road in the RM on a continuous basis must sign a 'Road Haul Agreement' with the municipality. The RM will decide which roads are to be utilized for the continuous hauling, and all road haul fees must be submitted to the municipality when the haul is completed, or prior to December 31st of any given year.

- New grader
- New mower
- Repairs to RR 2011, miles 7, 8, 9 (5 soft spots) \$186,000
- Gravel cost \$486,544 (23,784 yards used)
- Replaced \$66,000 in culverts
- Policing Costs: \$50,650

Challenges the Municipality is Facing:

- Infrastructure – roads (crowns, dirt base, width)
- Road allowances and bush pushing – hot topic

What's to come in 2024:

- Election: Reeve and Odd Divisions [November]
- New Tractor
- Bylaw Enforcement Officer has been contracted to remedy some of the reoccurring problems in the municipality [approx. \$23,400 cost annually]
- Replacement of 3 large culverts at New Holland [\$75,000]
- Possible New Grader purchase

- Securing land for Dunleath berm
- Rokeby Speed lights
